While we ate our soup, Mario began to make the next course, Eggs Benedict. He went step by step through the process for the hollandaise sauce (who knew it was just egg yolks and butter?) and of course, how to poach an egg! The end result was amazing, the sauce and the egg and the english muffin, and the ham, it was heavenly. While we all enjoyed our eggs, Mario began to prep for the next course, chicken crepes. We watched as he expertly whipped up the crepe batter and delicately flipped them. Along with the chicken they were topped with a beautiful champagne and shallot sauce. They were also very yummy! As we all became closer to a food coma, Mario told us about our final course, dessert! He prepared a lovely fruit bouche, filling puff pastry dough with a warm berry mixture. It was so tasty, especially paired with a nice scoop of vanilla ice cream.

Not only will you learn a lot and taste some really great dishes but you'll also have fun!
